Michigan Humane and Premier Pet Supply Join Forces with Winter Community Pet Food Drive

Joint food drive reflects ongoing commitment to serving community pets in need

DETROIT (Jan. 23, 2026) - Michigan Humane announced today a joint pet food drive with metro Detroit pet supply retailer Premier Pet Supply to support food donations to southeastern Michigan families and their pets. Into the first month of 2026, Michigan Humane continues to see a deeper need for pet food assistance in the community is greater than ever before.

From Jan. 23, 2026, to Feb. 22, 2026, Michigan Humane will be collecting pet food donations at all 14 Premier Pet Supply locations across metro Detroit, along with drop-off locations at their Detroit and Westland locations. In support of the community food drive, Premier Pet Supply is offering a special discount to donors who purchase food in store and online with code MHPP26. Supporters may also “round up” their in-store purchases, with Premier Pet Supply donating that money directly back to Michigan Humane.

Food insecurity affects the whole family, and as Michigan Humane and Premier Pet Supply believe, pets are a part of families.

“Time and again, this community has risen to the occasion when pets needed them the most. The rising need for pet food in the community will take all of us to solve,” said Michigan Humane President & CEO Matt Pepper. “We are so glad to be joined by Premier Pet Supply as we try to fill the belly of every hungry animal in metro Detroit.”

Since 2017, Michigan Humane has put more than 10 million pounds of pet food into the community, which has resulted in keeping families together and pets out of shelters. The capacity to help pets and the community is only limited by the amount of food the organization has access to.

The pet food drive isn’t the first collaboration between Michigan Humane and Premier Pet Supply. For more than two decades, Premier Pet Supply Founder and Owner Mike Palmer has been dedicated to supporting metro Detroit pets and their people.

“We have valued our partnership with Michigan Humane for over 20 years. The Caplan Family Pet Food Pantry, in particular, is an initiative we have always been very fond of,” said Palmer. “The effort to do everything we can, as a community, to help keep pets with their families where they are loved and cared for is incredibly important. Not only does this benefit the welfare of the animal, but the impact pets have in a home is irreplaceable.”
